Vintage Notes

The 2008 harvest was later than average. Springtime and summer were dryer than previous growing years resulting in smaller, more concentrated berries. White varietals will show exceptional quality with developed aromatics, fruit definition and balanced acidity levels. Red varietals also are showing great quality with aromatic intensity, good fruit concentration, juicy mouth and outstanding tannin quality. The 2008 vintage promises wines of freshness, brightness and balanced.

Tasting Note

Aromatic notes of raspberry and strawberry rhubarb invite you to this Pinot Noir. Juicy fruit marries with hibiscus and tea leaves on the palate. The balanced flavors are rounded out by cocoa, vanilla and blackberry on the finish.
