Vintage Notes

Following a cold, wet winter and a cool spring, budbreak and veraison were delayed significantly, up to three weeks in some places. And with cool temperatures running through March and April, late-ripening red varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon and Carmenere struggled to catch up in some areas. Growers were waiting into May (the equivalent of November in the northern hemisphere) to finish picking, but were optimistic thanks to dry weather.

Tasting Note

Aromatic notes of raspberry and strawberry rhubarb invite you to this Pinot Noir. Juicy fruit marries with hibiscus and tea leaves on the palate. The balanced flavors are rounded out by cocoa, vanilla and blackberry on the finish.
